

TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

Selangor Crown Prince Golf Charity Cup 2026

The following Terms of the Competition apply to the Selangor Crown Prince Golf Charity Cup 2026. Except for the updates to the event year, venue, date and minor grammatical improvements, the rules and conditions remain unchanged from the previous edition.

1. MANAGEMENT

The SAY Selangor Crown Prince Golf Charity Cup 2026 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Tournament') is organised by SAY (hereinafter referred to as 'the Event Organiser'). The Tournament shall be managed by the Event Organiser, which shall appoint a Tournament Committee ('the Committee'). The Committee's decisions on all matters relating to the Tournament shall be final.

2. VENUE AND DATE

29 August 2026

Kota Permai Golf & Country Club

3. FORMAT OF PLAY

The Tournament will be played over 18 holes using the Stableford System 36, allowing for a same-day handicap system. This format enables golfers without an official handicap index to compete using net scores.

4. MAXIMUM SCORES

The maximum score on any hole is par +3. Once this score is reached, players must pick up their ball, record the maximum score and proceed to the next hole. Players who withdraw during a round will receive the maximum score for all remaining holes.

5. TEEING AREAS

Men will play from the Blue tees. Ladies will play from the Red tees.

6. CADDIES

Caddies will be provided by the Event Organiser. Personal caddies are not permitted.

7. ELIGIBILITY

The Tournament is open to all Malaysian and non-Malaysian amateur golfers, both male and female.

8. ENTRIES

Entries must be received no later than two (2) weeks before the Tournament date or will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Entry fees are non-refundable. Transfers to another player are permitted with written notification at least seven (7) days before the event, subject to approval by the Event Organiser.

9. REGISTRATION

Players must register in person at least 30 minutes before the registration counter closes. Failure to do so may result in withdrawal without refund.

10. RULES OF PLAY

Play shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved by The R&A, the Local Rules of the host venue and any additional Local Rules issued by the Committee. Penalty for breach of a Local Rule is two strokes unless otherwise stated.

11. CONFORMING GOLF BALLS

Only golf balls listed on the current R&A List of Conforming Golf Balls may be used. Breach of this rule results in disqualification.

12. DRAW AND STARTING TIME

Players will compete in groups of up to four (4). The Committee will prepare the draw. The Tournament will use a shotgun start and all players must be at their assigned tee 10 minutes before tee-off. The Committee reserves the right to amend draws and starting times.

13. PACE OF PLAY

Rule 5.6 regarding pace of play applies. Penalties may be imposed for undue delay.

14. RULINGS BY THE COMMITTEE

Players must comply with a referee's ruling. The Committee's decision is final.

15. DECISION ON TIES

Ties will be decided by countback in the following order: lower handicap, last 18 holes, last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes and finally the 18th hole.

16. CODE OF CONDUCT

Players are expected to uphold the standards of conduct outlined in Rule 1.2a of the Rules of Golf.

17. SCORECARDS

Scorecards must be submitted within 15 minutes of completing the round. Both the player and marker must be present. A scorecard is considered submitted once accepted by the official scorer.

18. DISPUTES AND DECISIONS

Any rules dispute must be referred to the Committee before leaving the scoring area. Rule 20.1c(3) applies where two balls are played.

19. COMPETITION CLOSED

The Tournament is deemed closed once all prizes and trophies have been presented.

20. INCLEMENT WEATHER

The Committee may suspend or abandon play due to adverse weather or unplayable course conditions and determine the appropriate course of action.

21. INDEMNITY / LIABILITY

The Sponsors, Organisers, Committee and host venue accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury arising from participation or cancellation of the Tournament.

22. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT & CONSENT

By participating, players consent to the collection, processing and use of their personal data by SAY in accordance with its Privacy Policy.

23. CAPTURE AND USE OF IMAGES

Participants consent to being photographed, filmed and recorded during the Tournament for promotional and archival purposes.

24. AMENDMENTS

These Terms of the Competition may be amended at the discretion of the Tournament Organising Committee, whose decisions shall be final.

TOURNAMENT ORGANISING COMMITTEE

The Selangor Crown Prince Golf Charity Cup 2026 is managed by SAY. The Tournament Organising Committee reserves the right to accept, refuse or withdraw any entry, amend these Terms of the Competition and exclude any player at its discretion. The Committee shall conduct the Tournament in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved by The R&A, these Terms of the Competition and the Local Rules of the host venue. All decisions of the Committee are final.
